DATABASE AND GIS NEEDS ASSESSMENT

CDIS developed a Relational Database Management System (RDBMS) needs assessment survey and conducted an on-site Needs Assessment on Kadena Air Base, Okinawa, Japan for determining client requirements for the development of a Radon mitigation database specific to Military Family Housing. The proposed RDBMS is to integrate with the existing ArcView v3.2 GIS and AutoCAD 2000 drawings of the Military Family Housing units and surrounding structures of concern. CDIS conducted interviews with representatives from ten (10) Base entities identified as potential data providers and system users. A detailed database design and cost proposal that included a database dictionary, system model of the RDBMS interaction between the various users and the GIS, cost estimate, client presentation were developed and submitted.

A relational database management system (RDBMS), originally developed in Microsoft Access 97, (eventually upgraded to Microsoft Access 2000), is used to track and update the status of over 600 petroleum, oil and lubricant-containing (POL) components through the various stages of environmental restoration (close-in-place, removal, verification sampling, etc.) in support of the Air Force Environmental Resources Program. The POL RDBMS data are integrated with the AFCEE Environmental Resources Program Information Management System (ERPIMS) (via a secured Internet connection), MicroStation CADD 5.0-generated and AutoCAD 2000 site maps for query. Data analysis initially conducted via ESRI ArcView v3.2 and now via ArcGIS. Responsible for the analysis and verification of environmental sampling data associated with remedial construction activities via the GIS. Project sites analyzed include those at Hickam Air Force Base, Wake Island, and Anderson Air Force Base.

FINANCIAL TRACKING DATABASE SYSTEM

Constructed a financial tracking database system (FTS), developed initially with Microsoft Access 97 (upgraded to Microsoft Access 2000), for the purposes of delivering monthly status reporting of contract and project awards, modifications, project estimates, and request for changes to the U.S. Navy Contractor Technical Representative for over sixty (60) remedial construction projects. The FTS was migrated to a secured Web-based application for access by the primary contractor and Navy client. Site development included test and integration of Visual Basic, JavaScript, and VBScript components to create an interactive, real-time experience for the users of the online FTS. Project sites tracked are based in the Pacific and Indian Ocean areas, including Hawaii, Guam, Midway Island, Wake Island, Diego Garcia, Johnston Atoll, Wake Island, Southeast Asia, and Alaska.

SOFTWARE EVALUATION

CDIS reviewed existing and current Far East District (FED) data formats of well bore log data, related environmental database files and related software, and provided evaluation of ten (10) commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) environmental database management software packages.
